Job Description

Title: Junior Firefighter

Reports To: Station Officer/Post Advisors *Division:*
Operations/Junior Post

Summary: Participate in post activities sponsored through the Eureka Fire Protection District. Participates in training, PR, and acts as an assistant during approved ride along.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend 75% of trainings (18 of the 24) 2 of which are mandatory attendance. 24 hrs advanced notice is required for not attending training.
- Attend Fund Raisers for the post.
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA while in school, maintaining a C or higher grade in each class.
- Participate in a minimum of 8 hrs per month of engine house hours (The 8 hours of training does count towards this.)
- Assist with the day to day operations of the stations, determined by the officer in charge.
- Respond to calls with the Duty Crew (not on their own)
- Adhere to all SOPs and SOGS set forth by the Fire District

Competency:

To perform the job successfully, an individual should demonstrate the following

- Team work-Contribute to building a positive team spirit.
- Attendance - Consistently on time for events and functions.
- Dependability - Follows instructions, and responds to management directions.
- Initiative – Undertakes self-development activities; ask for and offers to help as needed.
- Professionalism - Reacts well under pressure; and treats others with respect.
- Safety and Security - Observes safety and security procedures; report potentially unsafe conditions.

Work Environment:

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those a Junior encounters while performing essential functions of this position, reasonable accommodations will be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform these essential functions. Furthermore, Juniors may be exposed to extreme weather conditions as well as working around moving mechanical items, All attempts will be made NOT to place a Junior in harms way. All safety precautions will be taken during training evolutions and/or calls. TurnOut Gear will be provided by the district, Juniors need to supply a pair of leather gloves and safety style duty boots black in color for themselves.

Physical Demands:

- Regularly lift/move 10 lbs, Frequently lift/move 25 lbs, Occasionally lift move 100lbs.
- Must have good vision with either glasses or corrective contact lenses
- Must have good hearing.
- Must be able to crawl, walk, stoop, crouch or stand for periods of time.

Skills:

- Basic Computer Skills; including data entry, and internet browsing.

Abilities:

- Math: add, subtract, multiply, divide all units of measurement.
- Language: Read and understand documents, instructions, manuals, etc ...
- Reasoning: solve problems in a multitude of situations; interpret a variety of instructions furnished in either oral, written diagram, or schedule forms.
