

**EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
RESERVE REQUIREMENTS**

Dear Prospective member:

The Eureka Fire Protection District is an expanding department, which has many demands, put on us. We would like, very much, to have interested people involved in helping us to provide the services to the community, and hopefully, you could be a part of our organization.

We request a lot from our members, and therefore, we try to give them as much as we possibly can. We will provide the best possible training and equipment that we have available to us and strive to improve at all times. The fire service is a field, which is constantly changing, and the need for training is very important.

We hope you will review this packet and ask any and all, questions which you have before making your decision. We hope you decide that you would like to become a part of our organization.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1.) Attend a minimum of 8 hours of District approved training per month. Training is held each shift throughout the week, twice on Wednesday, and on weekends when available.
- 2.) We expect you to put in a minimum of twenty-four hours per month at the engine house, over and above the training sessions. It is suggested that you periodically switch engine houses. These hours would be time that you would spend at the engine house in a minimum of four (4) hour increments, standing by and assisting the duty crew with that days operations and running calls.
- 3.) Attend the alarms so that you may utilize the training that you have gained through the training sessions.

NOTE: Failure to meet these requirements for one quarter is ground for removal from the staff .

If you are accepted you will need to present copies of the following:

- Drivers license
- Social Security Card
- Any professional licenses
- All current EMS cards
- High School Diploma
- Any other Fire / EMS certifications
- Military Discharge form DD-214
