

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SAFEGUARDING OF LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM THE HAZARDS OF FIRE OR EXPLOSION ARISING FROM THE STORAGE, HANDLING AND USE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES, MATERIALS AND DEVICES; AND FROM CONDITIONS HAZARDOUS TO LIFE OR PROPERTY IN THE USE OR OCCUPANCY OF BUILDINGS OR PREMISES; KNOWN AS THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE AND AMENDING EXISTING ORDINANCE # 12 OF THE EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY AND JEFFERSON COUNTY, STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCE REPEALED;

That ordinance number 12 of the Eureka Fire Protection District is hereby amended.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE;

That certain documents, three (3) copies of which are on file in the Office of the Bureau of Fire Prevention of the Eureka Fire Protection District, being marked and designated as "The BOCA National Fire Prevention Code, Eighth Edition 1990 and all it's Appendixes", as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., is hereby amended as the Fire Prevention Code of the Eureka Fire Protection District of St. Louis County and Jefferson County in the State of Missouri; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each of all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of said BOCA National Fire Prevention Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made part hereof, as fully set out in this Ordinance with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, as prescribed in Section 3 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE # 26:
(EXPLOSIVES, AMMUNITION, AND BLASTING AGENTS)

F-2600.2 PERMIT REQUIRED:

Page 133 & 134. delete the words "A permit shall be obtained from" and insert the words "Notification shall be made to."

F-2600.3 BOND REQUIRED FOR BLASTING:

Page 134. delete in its entirety.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE # 27:
(FIREWORKS)

F-2700.2 PERMIT REQUIRED:

Page 145. delete the words "A permit shall be obtained from" and insert the words "Notification shall be made to."

F-2700.3 PERMIT APPLICATIONS:

Page 145. delete the words "Application for permits" and insert the word "Notification."

Also delete the last two lines "The sale, possession, use and distribution of fireworks for such display shall be lawful under the terms and conditions approved with the permit and for that purpose only. A permit granted hereunder shall not be transferable, nor shall any such permit be extended beyond the dates set out herein."

F-2701.2: BOND FOR DISPLAY:

Page 145. delete in its entirety.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE # 3;
(GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AGAINST FIRE)

F-301.3 PERMIT REQUIRED:
Page 29. delete in its entirety.

F-301.4.3 PERMIT ISSUED:
Page 29. delete in its entirety.

F-301.5 NOTIFICATION AND PERMISSION:
Page 29 & 30. delete the last sentence as follows: "When jurisdictional EPA written permission is not applicable, the code official shall give written permission only after it has been determined that approved fire safety requirements and emission standards are to be met."

F-301.6 NOTIFICATION:
Page 30. delete the word "Application" and insert the word "Notification."

F-301.10 OPEN BURNING PROHIBITED:
Page 30. delete the words "permit holder" in the last sentence and insert the words "property owner and/or agent."

SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE:


Nothing in this Ordinance hereby amended shall be construed to effect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or Ordinance hereby amended as cited in Section One of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or effected by this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY:


If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance.
