

AN ORDINANCE
FOR THE RENUMBERING OF ORDINANCES
OF THE EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
AND PROVIDING FOR
NUMBERING OF BILLS TO INTRODUCE ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Eureka Fire Protection has several various ordinances enacted since the creation of the District; and,

WHEREAS, the numbering of said ordinances has become confusing because of the various amendments to ordinances over the years:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE RENUMBERING OF ORDINANCES OF THE EUREKA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND PROVIDING FOR NUMBERING OF BILLS TO INTRODUCE ORDINANCES.

SECTION ONE: Including this instant ordinance, the Eureka Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, has twenty-five (25) ordinances, active and inactive, current and outdated.

SECTION TWO: The numbering system of ordinances of the Eureka Fire Protection District shall commence after this particular ordinance with the No. 1, which ordinance shall be the Fire Prevention Code of the Eureka Fire Protection District. The ordinances of the Eureka Fire Protection District shall be renumbered as follows:

SECTION THREE. Numbering of Bills for the submission of ordinances.

Henceforth, all bills for the introduction of ordinances of the Eureka Fire Protection District shall be numbered with the actual number of the bill together with a hyphen after which shall follow the year designation. The numbering of each bill shall begin at "1" with each year, showing the particular year designation. An example would be as follows: "Bill 2-87". The fourth bill submitted in 1988 would be shown as "bill 4-88". Thus the first number would be the actual number of the bill for that time period and the remaining two digits would designate the actual year in which the bill was submitted.

SECTION FOUR: Effective date. This Ordinance No. 24 having been duly considered and voted upon by the Board of Directors of the Eureka Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, is now duly adopted, enacted and effective as an Ordinance of the Eureka Fire Protection District of St. Louis County, Missouri, on this _____ day of _____, 1987, and shall become effective as provided by law.
